

# GLENN COUNTY MOSQUITO FOGGING SCHEDULE (July 1, 2011)

Fogging Begins at Dusk (Weather Permitting)

**MONDAY:** Willows Area, City of Willows, Hotspots Countywide.

**TUESDAY:** All Surrounding Orland Area, City of Orland, Lake School Area & Capay Area, Areas up to Hamilton City Community Services Boundary

**WEDNESDAY:** Artois Area, Blue Gum, Greenwood Switch, between County Roads 25 and 39.

**THURSDAY:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday: North River Area (Ord Bend, Bayliss Area, Plaza). 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday: South River Area (Butte City, Afton, Glenn-Cordora Areas). Willows Area.

**FRIDAY:** Any Rural Area not gotten during the week because of weather and Extra service request, as well as any hotspots.

***This schedule may change at any time due to weather and/or vector-borne disease activity and mosquito biting complaints. Also spray routes and schedule will also change and/or shift when different mosquitoes species become more prevalent within an area of the county.***

Fogging occurs in the evening following sunset when mosquitoes are the most active. Fogging is dependent on weather and winds may delay fogging. There is a minimum of three hours of spraying per evening. Additionally, spraying occurs based on surveillance and mosquito activity. This means that some areas may be sprayed more often than as listed in this schedule.
