Actuals not closed yet due to fiscal year end.

Fuel sales are down 79% at WLW and 68% at 037 since price increase last order. Current fuel price at 037 is \$7.92 and WLW is \$7.91.

Alex Galvan shared that the Road crew has put up signage for the airport driveway and behind Nancy's Airport Café. Have had to ask squatters to move off airport property at WLW. Approximately Fifty gallons of fuel was stolen from 037; lock was cut off. Claim has been submitted. Mr. Galvan is now taking handles to reduce possibility of future theft. Ball valve has been replaced. There was a crash at WLW, landing gear collapsed, no injuries or damage to anything or anyone, other than the plane. Need to weed eat at 037 where helicopters were stationed.

and legal information and will bring findings back to committee.

Chair Kraemer clarified, we (AAC) are an advisory committee and we can bring suggestions to staff but, final decisions are made by Board of

Supervisors (BOS)?

Mr. Rust stated County Counsel represents the BOS. AAC members may come to the BOS meeting as a citizen to express thoughts and or concerns. Member Lely inquired if Lessees could sell their hangars on Land Leases (PAPs/Buildings). Mr. Nocks responded once we review, we will share our findings on these questions.

Mr. Rust explained, bottom line, we follow FAA rules.

Chair Kraemer asked to clarify, are we a Commission or a Committee?

Mr. Rust replied an Advisory Committee. The committee may bring an "Action Item" to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) as a "Recommendation" but, the BOS has the right to pass or fail the recommendation.
