Weinrich added \$4900.00 for three-month rental cost on the pump came out of that and he is awaiting an estimate for the Cherry Street backup pump from Durham Pump. Mr. Grube shared that he is looking into funding possibility from CDBG Reuse Grant and we will need a community survey for eligibility. Member Ward commented the run off system has changed due to farm lands changing to orchards and inquired if they can raise the easement on South Willows. Mr. Grube responded the Board of

Supervisors is aware of these land changes. Member Murray inquired of a land leveling permit. Mr. Grube explained cost and no pre-existing information on land

leveling makes it difficult.
