THE POSITION

The Physical Therapist position at the Glenn County Children's Services Medical Therapy Unit specializes in treating and caring for clients who are children with conditions related to genetic, neurological, and orthopedic disorders. This position requires a Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree from an accredited program, must have passed the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam, be currently licensed in the State of California, and must be CCS Program paneled. This position is at-Will, Temporary and Part-Time - scheduled for up to sixteen (16) hours per week.
