Glenn County Hosts Second Annual Veterans Stand Down on January 21, 2026

ORLAND, CA – Glenn County Health & Human Services (HHSA) and Community Action Department (CAD) and will host the Second Annual Glenn County Veterans Stand Down on Wednesday, January 21, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Glenn County Fairgrounds, located at 221 E. Yolo Street, Orland, CA.

The Veterans Stand Down is a free, one-day event dedicated to honoring local veterans by connecting them with vital resources, services, and community support in a single, welcoming location. Veterans and their families from all branches of the U.S. Armed Forces from our local counties are encouraged to attend.

The event will provide access to a wide range of services and supports, including but not limited to:

- Veteran benefits information and assistance
- Health and wellness resources
- Housing and social services support
- Free haircuts for Veterans
- Community-based organizations and service providers
- Food, giveaways, and on-site assistance
- Military vehicles and memorabilia

The Stand Down model is designed to reduce barriers for veterans by offering coordinated, respectful, and veteran-centered support.
