- Certification specialist will be leaving and the position has been filled to begin the first week of April, this could cause delay in receiving certifications
- Participating in county trainings with healthcare partners
- The Emergency Preparedness Training Workshop is in May and the RDMHS will be running a tabletop
- OES/OEM
 - Amy Travis; Glenn County OES – there are several winter storms that caused infrastructure damage which remain in recovery mode. Willows Airport’s main runway was impacted and remains closed. Glenn County is in the process of getting a state of emergency declared.
 - Updated/reviewed the Glenn Mitigation Plan, it is currently with CalOES for review
 - The county EOP is due for an update, this will be the primary focus of the OES for the next year. Partners may be contacted to provide input.
- Hospitals
 - Enloe - trauma certification renewal went well, with a focus on how involved Enloe has been with the community and healthcare partners.
 - New helicopter is due to arrive soon.
 - This is Patty Arena’s last meeting before retirement. Her replacement is Kim Freedle
 - Orchard Hospital & Glenn Medical Center - recently did a tabletop on a wind emergency scenario.
 - A new ambulance for interfacility transfers will be received in the near future
 - Veterans’ Association - participated in the Butte Co. Covid After Action Report and found the process very valuable
- Clinics – no updates provided
- Long Term Care Facilities – no updates provided
- Home Health Organizations
 - Reviewing all policies and emergency procedures across the network of facilities
- Organizations serving AFN populations.
 - Dean Strait – just went through a recertification process, waiting on the final results.
