Invoices Arriving by June 1st

Invoices for the 2021-2022 coverage year (effective 7/1/2021) are scheduled to be distributed by June 1st. These will reflect your final Annual Contribution for the upcoming year and include any estimated payroll or schedule adjustments (property, vehicles, etc.) that have been made since the release of Contribution Indications in April. The invoices will also include any remaining balance for the 2019-2020 Final Contribution Adjustment (aka “True-up”) and the 2021-2022 General Liability Dividend (read about the Dividend [here](#)).

There is still time to make adjustments to your payroll or scheduling, if necessary. We ask that any adjustments be made by Wednesday, May 26th, so we can capture them prior to releasing invoices.
