2014 Permit Conditions Permit Conditions for Dicamba

FOR APPLICATION OF DICAMBA WITHIN THE TWO (2) MILE BUFFER AREA (Grapes)

1. 24 hour notice of intent.
2. Only ground equipment may be used in Glenn County. Applications made by ground equipment during the time period beginning April 1 and continuing through Oct 15th of each calendar year shall be made in accordance with the following requirements:
 - A) Each operating nozzle used for applications to field or row crops, (non orchard), shall produce spray droplets of 500 microns vmd (dvo.5) (or equivalent) or larger in size with 10% of the diameter by volume (dvo.1) not less than 200 microns.
3. No application shall be made if the temperature exceeds 90° degrees Fahrenheit.
4. Air flow must be away from the grapes with a steady wind not less than 2 mph or greater than 10 mph.
5. A smoke column, for use in determining climatic conditions, must be used prior to the commencement of the application.
6. Growers shall call the weather station at (530) 982-1021 to obtain wind speed data and temperature conditions. Calls shall be made prior to, and at the end of the application. This information must be recorded by the applicator and made available to the Agricultural Commissioner upon request. Must be submitted with the use report.
7. The amount of acres treated each day near a sensitive site will be limited. DO NOT TREAT MORE THAN _____ ACRES PER DAY.
8. A pre-site inspection must be conducted by the Agricultural Commissioner prior to the use of Dicamba within the 2 mile buffer area.
