There has been a big increase of referrals in October and that has shifted their services a bit. | | | <u>Behavioral Health Director Report-</u> Cindy stated that referral numbers are up. Our workforce is still struggling we are still short hand. We are actively recruiting. Joe's report- Cindy explained that we were granted a grant to fund a new building for the youth and family, we are receiving a little over 17 million dollars to get this project started. We are also partnering with Sierra Wellness who will be taking over After-hours crisis calls, they are currently training. Care court is coming to a start and moving along, it is a program to engage the homeless into getting treatment, this program will start in the fall. |
| | | <u>David reported out on HH-</u> Had their Thanksgiving putlock last month. Harmony House will be closing down for a few days because they will be painting the center the last week of the year. They have a new staff and they will be holding interviews tomorrow for a fourth coaching position. |

They will also be holding their Christmas get together on the 16 th for any youth who wishes to participate.
