No one had attended. - SPEAKS first planning meeting will be held tomorrow on zoom and in person – BHAB should be tabling at the event. (First week in September) - Friday, May 12 is Walk for Change – Susie will man a table and hand out BHAB brochures and the 50 hygiene kits sent to MHSA Manager by #Take Action 3:30 to 6:00 pm - - Co-Chair: Susie reported that she will not be sitting on the committee for Purpose Place to select applicants. - - MHSA Manager: Cindy will review results of MHSA stakeholder input at next regular Advisory Board meeting. - - Analyzed data from MHSA Stakeholder Surveys. Results show community concern for suicide, especially in the children’s age group 0-15, and Co-Occurring Disorders for TAY Youth. Homelessness was another concern addressed, and this was listed as the highest underserved community. The second was noted as co-occurring and veterans. The surveys noted information on Behavioral Health was shared primarily through word of mouth. Surveys were submitted by a diverse population representing a diverse perspective from the community. Parenting needs were another issue noted. GCBH is currently writing our MHSA 3-year plan. One noted change is shifting the Parent-Child Interactive Therapy modality to a different evidence-based practice. - Cindy Ross and Elise Garrison are applying for a lethal means prevention grant as part of suicide prevention activities.
