WE ARE FACING A FENTANYL CRISIS





Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid that is up to 50 times stronger than heroin and 100 times stronger than morphine.

The number of overdose deaths involving synthetic opioids in 2020 was more than 18 times the number in 2013.

More than 56,000 people died from overdoses involving synthetic opioids in 2020.

Ways to stay safe:

- Always carry Narcan
- Utilize fentanyl test strips
- Always call 911 after administering Narcan

SIGNS OF FENTANYL POISONING

- small, constricted pupils
- falling asleep/loss of consciousness
- Weak/slow or no breathing
- choking/gurgling sounds
- limp body
- cold and/or clammy skin
- discolored skin



Remember to call 911 after you administer Narcan. The Good Samaritan Law offers protection to those who seek emergency services at the scene of a suspected drug overdose.
