The County of Glenn and the City of Orland invite small business owners in Orland or unincorporated Glenn County to participate in an Informational Session regarding the new COVID-19 Business Assistance Grant programs.

- **CDBG-CV1 County of Glenn** – Unincorporated areas of Glenn County
- **CDBG-CV1 City of Orland** – Within city limits of Orland
- **CARES Act – All of Glenn County** (Including Willows, Orland, and all unincorporated areas)

If your business meets the following criteria, you may be eligible to receive a grant to offset losses from COVID-19:

Eligibility

- Must have a Brick and Mortar presence in jurisdiction.
- The business has to have fewer than five employees for CDBG-CV1 Microenterprise grants.
- The business must have fewer than 100 employees for CARES Act Small Business Assistance grants.
- Stay-at-home orders and mandated shutdowns must be causing an impact to business revenue.
- Glenn County resident must own majority of business.
- National chains and franchises are not eligible for CDBG-CV1 funds.
- National chains and franchises are eligible for CARES Act funds.
