The Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority has released for a 30-day public review under the California Environmental Quality Act an Initial Study (IS)/ Environmental Assessment and draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) on the effects of proposed in basin water transfers from willing sellers to buyers in the Sacramento Valley. This IS/EA analyzes transfers of Central Valley Project water from entities in northern California to participating members of the Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority. The water would be made available for transfer through a combination of cropland idling and groundwater substitution. The transfers could originate in Colusa, Glenn, Sacramento, Shasta, Sutter, Tehama, or Yolo counties. The transfer buyers could be in Colusa, Glenn, Tehama, or Yolo counties.
