<p>A. <u>HOUSEHOLD AND COMMERCIAL REFUSE</u> \$70.00/TON</p> <p>B. <u>CONSTRUCTION/DEMOLITION WASTE</u> \$70.00/TON</p> <p>C. <u>CLEAN GREEN AND WOOD WASTE</u> \$70.00/TON</p> <p>D. <u>TIRES</u> Loads of more than 9 whole tires must present a tire hauling manifest. Contact CA Department of Transportation for details of tire hauling regulations</p> <p>1. Whole tires</p> <p> a. Tires up to 20 inches (or on rim) \$ 4.00 ea.</p> <p> b. Tires 20 to 24 inches \$12.25 ea.</p> <p> c.. Tires over 24 inches \$40.25 ea.</p> <p>E. <u>APPLIANCES:</u></p> <p>1. Refrigeration units (Refrigerators, freezers, air-conditioners, etc.)</p> <p> a. Without Freon \$10.00</p> <p> b. With Freon (or without certificate) \$35.00 ea.</p> <p>2. Washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, hot water heaters, space heaters, boilers, furnaces \$10.00 ea.</p> <p>F. <u>BULKY AND HARD TO HANDLE ITEMS</u></p> <p>1. Hide-a-beds, couches, recliners, other bulky or hard to handle, etc. \$ 20.00 ea.</p> <p>G. <u>MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS</u></p> <p>1. Clean and Dry \$ FREE</p> <p>2. Damaged, twisted, wet, frozen or soiled \$20.00 ea.</p> <p>H. <u>RECYCLING DROP-OFF:</u> FREE</p> <p>1. Aluminum, glass, plastic, paper, cardboard</p> <p>2. Antifreeze, Oil & Oil Filters, Paint</p>	<p>3. Clean Scrap Metal & Steel – no oil, compressor oil, fuel, mercury switches, and mercury thermostats.</p> <p>4. Batteries (all kinds, must be sorted and terminals covered)</p> <p>5. Ag Plastics (triple rinsed, dry, all metal and rubber removed, drums cut into quarters crosswise or lengthwise).</p> <p>I. <u>COMPUTERS, TELEVISIONS, MONITORS, MISC. E-WASTE</u></p> <p>1. 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K. **ADDITIONAL FEES:**

1. Extra handling fees of \$50 per hour (minimum one hour) will be applied to the following:
 - a. Contaminated recycling
 - b. Compromised roll offs - Individuals renting roll off containers are responsible for payments for any and all materials present when the load is dumped. You will be billed for any appliances as noted above, as well as a \$50 per hour charge for Transfer Station staff to remove the electronics, appliances, hazardous waste, paint, oil, batteries, or other materials that are required to be kept out of the Transfer Station.
 - c. Spilled loads.
 - d. Contaminated loads – grossly unsorted loads containing banned materials; Also applies to roll-off loads containing banned items (see b. above).
 - e. Customers who are non-compliant with County Code and/or posted policies.
2. Loads that are not securely tied and covered \$15.00 ea.

Customers who arrive at the landfill with their load uncovered may be assessed this fee.
