

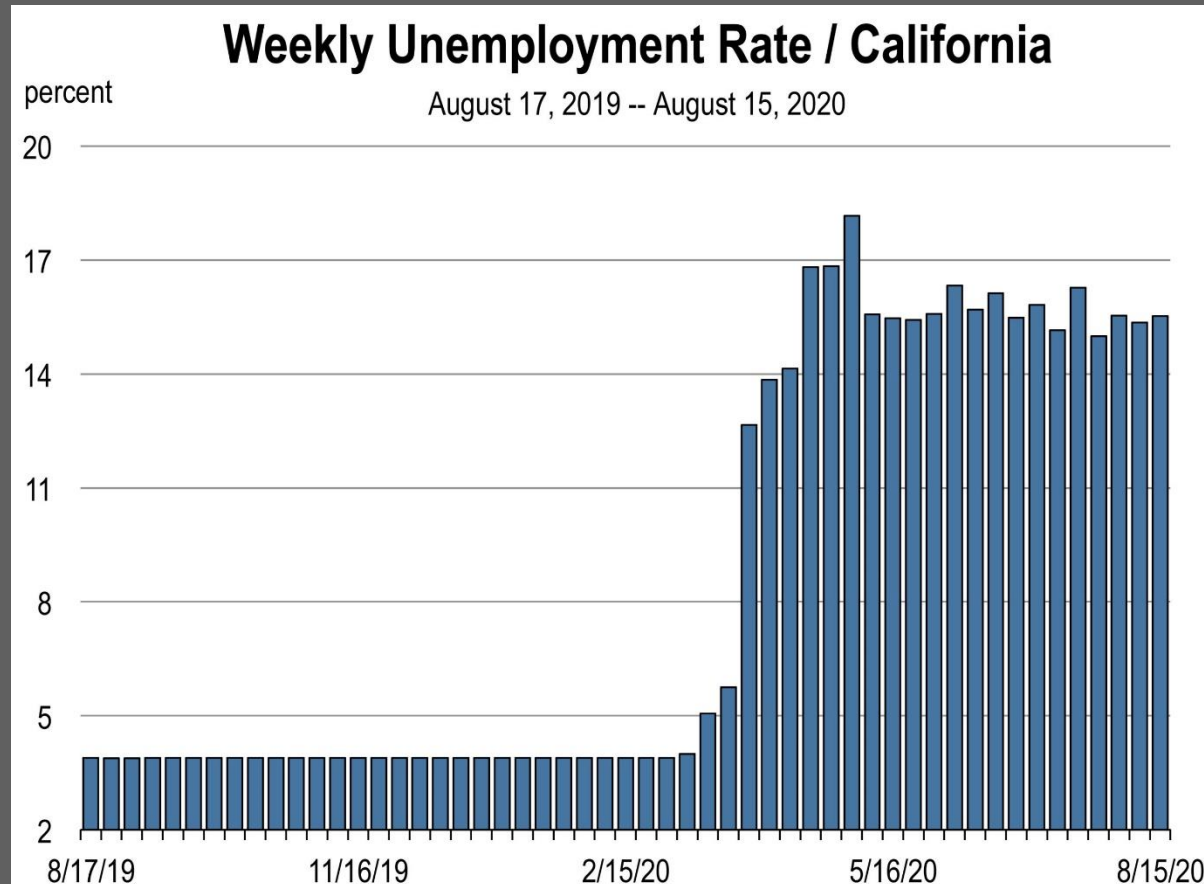

ECONOMIC EFFECTS OF COVID-19



CDBG-CV₁ MICROENTERPRISE GRANTS CARES ACT SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS

- CDBG-CV₁ Grants \$2,500-\$7,500 for businesses up to 5 employees
- CARES Act Grants \$10,000 to \$25,000 for businesses up to 100 employees

CDBG-CV ₁	\$18.7 Million	\$89,492	\$77,451
CARES Act	\$15.3 Billion	\$500,000	*

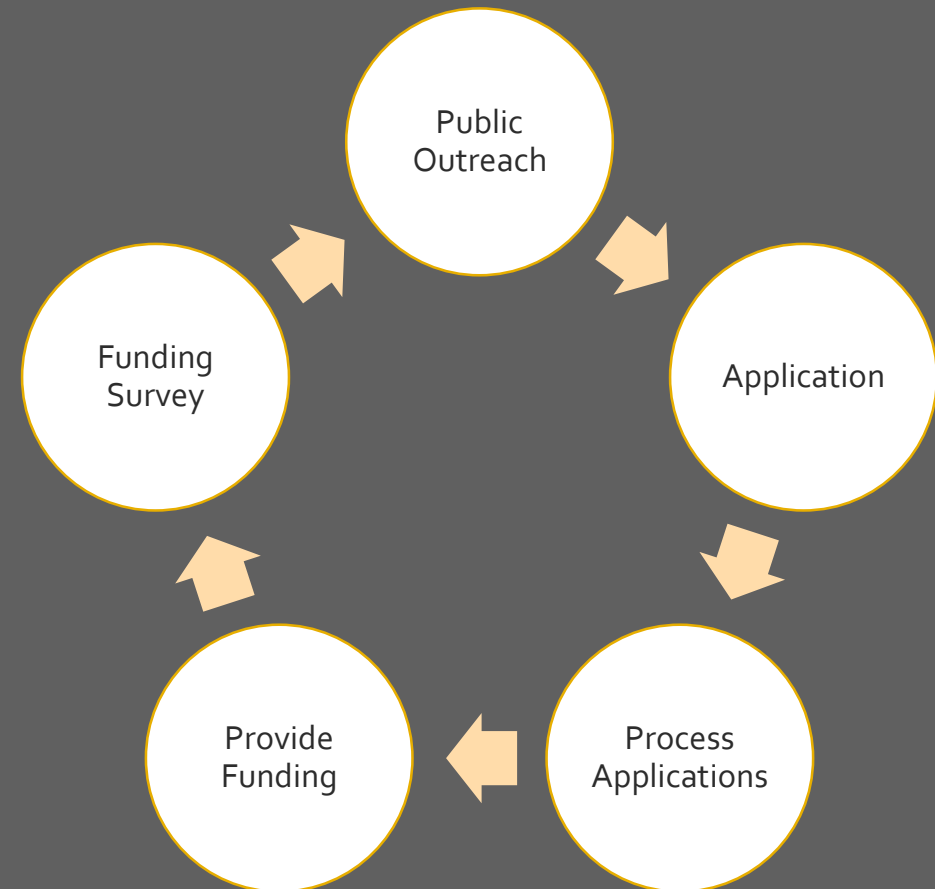
* Incorporated Orland and Willows are included with Glenn County for CARES Act funding.

ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANT PROGRAMS

- Must have a Brick and Mortar presence in jurisdiction.
- The business has to have fewer than five employees for CDBG-CV₁ Microenterprise grants.
- The business must have less than 100 employees for CARES Act Small Business grants.
- Stay-at-home orders and mandated shutdowns must be causing an impact to business revenue.
- Glenn County resident must own majority of business.
- National chains and franchises are not eligible CDBG-CV₁ funds.
- National chains and franchises are eligible for CARES Act funds.

GRANT PROCESS

- Grant Application period: November 2, 2020 through February 26, 2021
- CDBG-CV₁ disbursements to be completed before July 31, 2021
- CARES Act disbursements to be made before December 30th, 2020
- Please apply as soon as possible
