1) Welcome/Introductions

2) HPP Updates

- 1) Butte County has changed their radio operations. If your facility is still in possession of any 800 mhz radios, please return these radios to Matt Washburn.
- 2) HVA Updates
 - Hazard and Vulnerability Assessments require annual review. Please send final copy to your Public Health Emergency Preparedness Coordinator. This information is used to assist not only facilities in their own preparedness drills but also Public Health for coalition drills.
- 3) Extreme Heat Planning
 - Any adverse events must be reported to Public Health Department.
- 4) Drought Forecast and Mitigation
 - Butte County has had a locally declared state of emergency for drought.
 - Drought resources are available per DWR list (Included with minutes).
 - Glenn County has an available page for drought response as well.
- 5) HPP Bed Polls
 - Updating disaster contact lists
 - a. Butte County Public Health has been required to call a number of facilities to check bed availability for possible relocation of patients/residents from neighboring counties. Several facilities still have not updated their emergency contact lists.
 - Updating bed polls
 - a. When bed polls are being prompted through EMResource, facilities are required to input data. As we are currently in a regional emergent event, this is of the utmost importance.
- 6) SitRep/Resource Requests
 - If your facility is experiencing any issues, please remember to submit a SitRep/Resource Request to your local MHOAC.

3) COVID-19 Updates

- 1) In home vaccinations

- MyTurn allows individuals to receive in home COVID-19 vaccinations. Once received, they are forwarded to the appropriate County Health Departments for follow up.
 - a. For patients without transportation but are not homebound, there is also an option to receive transportation to a local COVID-19 vaccination clinic
- 2) Vaccination clinics are still available for Butte and Glenn County.
 - Both counties note number of vaccinations has decreased significantly
- 3) BinaxNOW COVID-19 antigen test kits are available.
 - Butte County partners interested are to reach out to Matt Washburn (mwashburn@buttecounty.net) for questions or requests.
 - a. Available at no cost to facilities. Current lots to expire in October 2021.
