1. Modify “Assumption 3” as follows “HCC Hospitals will notify Butte and Glenn ESF-8 per MHOAC program if resources are inadequate to provide usual standard of care.”
 2. The coalition discussed that Crisis Standard of Care is very dependent on the type of event. It is a difficult legal space to enter into – there is a risk to having it and a risk of not having it defined. Many feel it is a state level issue and the state should define the parameters and that discussion is needed at the state level. Coalition members have been unable to find much guidance or templates, either on ASPR Tracie or other sources of information.
 3. Several members of the coalition suggested an easier format for submitting Situation Status Reports during an event, such as using Survey Monkey. Butte and Glenn PH will look into whether this can be accomplished.

 - i. October 2108 survey to meet work plan needs. Low participation in the survey, Butte will follow-up on items.
