Amy Travis welcomed everyone to the new EOC for the Glenn County Operational Area. She explained that there is no backup power/generator for the building at this time. She is working on a FY 18/19 Homeland Security grant for a generator. A backup EOC can be the front building possibly, just needs a power transfer switch and can use existing generator. Alternate EOC locations have generator power and include Sheriff's Office and Memorial Hall in Willows – Board of Supervisor Chambers.

## EMS and LEMSA:

John Lord, SSV -

- May 15 Medical Control Committee John gave a review/update on EMS protocols resulting from this meeting.
- Please report equipment failures and med shortages to SSV.
- The transition for Glenn County to Cal Fire for air transport is complete.
- Pediatric intubation He is looking to get someone in the Northstate to present the data that shows there is no significant improvement in patient outcome when intubated.
- Applied for TXA (anti-hemorrhage) medication in the field.

Lori Finch, Westside Ambulance -

- Gave an update on the illegal trailer park situation west of Orland.
- John Lord stated they have a duty to respond to medical calls but if there is an unsafe scene, they can ask the person needing transport to come to a safe location (ie. County road/property line) but must document this in the PCR/med records and make sure these reflect the issue.

Mark Walker, Enloe EMS -

They are trying to get a repeater for their quarters at GMC.

#### OES/Law:

Amy Travis -

- The OA EOP is under revision. The plan and it's annexes will be revised and updated. It will be sent out for review by partners in the coming months.
- The Chrome Fire was a Level 1 activation and CodeRed was used.
- A jail evacuation plan is being developed.
- A full OA inventory of all emergency equipment using a new inventory system and Homeland Security grant funds will be conducted.
- Active Shooter kits, mega movers, and tourniquets were purchased for 1st responders and healthcare facilities

Kyle, CAL OES – The Northern CA Catastrophic Flood response plan has been approved. He introduced Robert Goyeneche, the Acting Deputy Regional Administrator.

## Fire:

OVFD – John McDermott – They have had some minor problems with dispatch but mostly pleased with the work being done on communications.

Hamilton City Fire – Dan James – He had questions on who at dispatch decides to tone out which department. It will be discussed at the Fire Chief's Meeting. He also suggested that just like flight crews notify dispatch when they are in the area, ground units should do so also.

Willows – Wayne Peabody – He commented that WFD are not dispatchers and that a central dispatch is needed. They are hiring a new firefighter. They are now allowed to carry & administer Narcan.

## HHSA:

Grinnell Norton, PH – She invited everyone in the community to enjoy the new building and said it is a resource for the community and should be used.

Laura Medina – She gave a report on the Butte-Glenn Emergency Preparedness Coalition surge test that was conducted on 6/4/18. Upcoming exercises include deploying the Mobile Tent/Field Hospital on 9/18/18.
