II. Agenda Items:

1. **Approval of the Minutes from the meeting held on March 29, 2012** - It was M/S/C to approve the minutes from the March 29, 2012 meeting with the correction to the spelling of the last name Enos in Item 6. Tree Removal Bids.

2. **Proposed Budget/Assessment** - The 2012-2013 proposed budget along with the assessment sheets set at .08 cents were passed out for discussion. The board had several questions regarding Services and Supplies and Other Charges in the 2012-2013 budget. After discussion the public hearing was opened.
3. **Public Hearing** - Scott opened the public hearing at 9:30 am to hear any comments on the proposed budget and assessment. The public had no comment regarding the proposed budget and assessment. Scott closed the public hearing at 9:35 am.

The Scott called for approval of the proposed budget and assessment. The 2012 -2013 budget and the 2012 -2013 assessment approval was M/S/C. All were in agreement.

4. **Appointment of New Chairman** - Scott called for nominations for the chairman opening. Dan Kennedy was nomination for chairman. Adam Englehardt was nominated for the vice chairman. Scott was reappointed for another four years. M/S/C All were in agreement.

5. **Additional Items**

- A) Olive Fruit Fly Counts - Ernie informed the board that counts (over 200 flies) at a property with six olive trees on road N. Ernie has placed magnet OL traps at this location and has not seen a reduction in flies. There is also a property on Road 23 and Hwy 99 that also has very high fly counts. It was discussed that Ernie and Jean would write a letter stating the options of control and that the OPMD would be willing to remove the trees for no charge. This letter will be hand delivered so Ernie can talk to the owners.
- B) Bill Krueger - Bill Krueger will be retiring from the California Cooperative Extension Office at the end of June 2012. He will not be able to put out the Olive Notes before he retires.
- C) Public Announcement - Jean talked about the Olive Fruit Fly article in the Sacramento Valley Mirror which addressed the very high counts found so far and that spraying should begin sooner than normal.
- D) Grower Concerns - A grower is concerned about two neighboring orchards. He believes the owners are not spraying for the Olive Fruit Fly. Dottie will need to place traps in the orchards as soon as possible.
- E) Olive Knot - Dan Kennedy will be testing the effects of peroxide treatment on Olive Knot in his orchard.
- F) Tree Removal - Jean received a letter from Mark Enos. He would like to work with the OPMD on removing three trees on his property. The OPMD will offer him \$527.30 for him to use for tree removal as the trees were too large for the District to remove.
