#### Glenn County to Close Some Business Sectors

California Department of Public Health has notified Glenn County that the following sectors must close or modify services due to increased transmission of the COVID-19 in our community. The closures or modifications are effective today, July 1, 2020 and are in effect for three weeks or July 22, 2020.

#### **Business Sectors that must close:**

- **Bars, pubs, wineries, breweries, and brewpubs**

#### **Businesses that must modify operations**

- **Restaurants – No indoor dining**
  - Takeout, delivery, or outdoor seating only
- **Family entertainment centers**
  - Indoor operations such as arcades, bowling, movie theaters etc. must be discontinued or closed
  - Outdoor activities may continue (example miniature golf)
- **Museums and zoos**
  - Must modify to outdoor operations or close
- **Cardrooms**
  - Must modify to outdoor operations or close

Glenn County was not provided advance notice from the State regarding this change in requirements and we understand the difficulty in implementing these measures on such short notice. We ask for patience from our community as our businesses adapt to the rapidly changing requirements.

The State has directed Glenn County Public Health to put these measures in effect as the result of being on the COVID-19 Monitoring List for more than three consecutive days. Glenn County is unable to meet three of the six metrics the State has established including new case rate, test positivity rate, and number of daily tests over the past 14 day period. Glenn County continues to meet three of the State metrics including low hospitalization rates of cases, available hospital surge capacity, personal protective equipment available for frontline personnel, as well as, no deaths with COVID-19 as the cause.

Glenn County has had a total 115 COVID-19 positive cases since March. Currently there are 33 active cases who are in isolation and 82 people who have recovered from COVID-19. Of the active cases, 3 people, over the age of 60, are hospitalized.
