Glenn County Confirms COVID-19 Case in a Healthcare Worker

Glenn County Public Health has received lab confirmation of a COVID-19 case in a healthcare worker who resides in Glenn County. Glenn County Public Health is conducting contact tracing of those who have had close, sustained contact with the case.

The individual who tested positive for COVID-19 is between 18-49 years of age and resides in the north part of the county.

As of today at 10:00 AM we have the following case count:

- Confirmed cases (3)
- Negative test results (49)

COVID-19 is present across the state of California. Community acquired COVID-19 can occur anywhere. It is important to stay at home except when conducting essential business to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.
