PROCESS

Candidates must submit a completed job application. Application packets will be screened and candidates considered best qualified will move forward to a competitive examination process, which may include a written exam, practical skills exam, an oral interview, fingerprinting/background check or medical examination process if applicable. Eligible lists are used for Full-Time (40 hrs./wk. with benefits), Part-Time (20-39 hrs./wk. with benefits), and Public Service employee (PSE) temporary (limited benefits).

THE POSITION

The PSE IV - Building Inspector position at the Glenn County Planning & Community Development Services Agency performs a variety of commercial, industrial and residential building inspection duties at various stages of construction, alteration and repair. Knowledge of the building trades industry and Trak-IT software is desirable. This position is at-will, temporary, part-time and scheduled for twenty-five (25) hours per week. This recruitment may be used to establish a list to fill future vacancies for the next twelve (12) months.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will be able to learn, understand, interpret and apply pertinent laws, codes and regulations of Glenn County, state and federal agencies.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Inspects industrial, commercial and residential buildings during various stages of construction alteration and repair throughout Glenn County to ensure compliance with applicable codes and regulations of County, state and federal agencies.
- Conducts joint inspections with other County departments.
- Performs zoning inspections.
- Confers with architects, contractors, builders and the general public in the field and office; explains and interprets requirements and restrictions.
- Inspects foundation, concrete, steel, masonry and wood construction; framing, plastering, plumbing, heating and electrical installations, and a large variety of other building system elements.
- Initiates and monitors violation procedures and eviction process during abatement of dangerous buildings.

About Glenn County Glenn County has a population of 28,122 and is located mid-way between Sacramento and Redding in Northern California. Glenn County is primarily an agricultural community with mountains on the west, the Sacramento River bounding the east side and the Interstate 5 corridor taking you through the rich farm land of the County. With over 1,188 farms, agriculture remains the primary source of Glenn County's economy. Major commodities include rice, almonds, milk products, prunes, bees and livestock.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Any combination of education and experience sufficient to directly demonstrate possession and application of the knowledge and ability to perform the job duties. These standards are typically attained with one year of related experience including at least twelve units of college or trade school course work that relates directly to the specified standards for this class; or two years of journey level experience in construction work and the building trades, involving work done in conformance to standard building codes, and completion of the 12th grade or equivalent.

License or Certificate:

- Possession of a valid California driver's license.
- Possession of an ICC certificate relevant to building inspection and/or possession of, or ability to obtain within one year of the date of hire, and maintain, an ICC building inspector certification. In addition to the ICC Building Inspector certification, the incumbent should have the ability to obtain and keep current relevant Building related certifications, such as electrical, mechanical, plumbing, etc. and maintain the additional certifications.
