July 12, 2012

MINUTES

PRESENT: Robert Maloney, Honorable Peter Twede, Honorable Donald C. Byrd, Sheriff Larry Jones, Lt. James Miranda, Sgt. Sonia Melgarejo, Chief William Spears, Tracey Quarne, Deputy Chief Probation Officer Rick Beatty, Chief J.C. Tolle, Lucy Hernandez, Al Scott, Glenn Myers, Pedro Bobadilla, David Allee, Tami Gilmore and Noreen Nunes. (Scott Gruendl was present via telephone)

Call To Order and Attendance: Rick Beatty called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

Approval of Minutes: The Minutes from the June 21, 2012, meeting were reviewed and Sheriff Jones made the motion to approve them with Chief Spears making the second motion.

Public Comments: No public comments were made.

Information/Discussion/Action Items: The AB funding allocation was handed out indicating amounts proposed for HRA; Drug/Alcohol/Mental Health; Orland Police Department; Willows Police Department; Probation Department and the Sheriff's Department all totaling \$662,540.00.

Rick explained to the police Chiefs their allocated amounts came from their assistance in searches, arrests, and other related duties.

Sheriff Jones indicated the amount his department was receiving was not enough. He stated a needed deputy would cost approximately \$110,000 (at the high step) and he has already spent \$76,262 on Sgt. Melgarejo's position. The need for more staff would assist in handling the increase in assaults in the jail, alternative sentencing, electronic monitoring, etc. He also stated he needed a new car and additional safety equipment.

Lucy Hernandez reiterated their amount needed for treatment costs and handed out a flow chart and an information sheet with the AB 109 roles and responsibilities of each department involved.

Scott Gruendl stated that there was not enough current information to make a recommendation to the Executive Committee. Judge Byrd added that the departments need to have firm numbers based upon accurate information. He wants to have the final plan put in place and submitted to the Executive Committee for consideration at the July 19, 2012, meeting. If this cannot be in place by the designated day, then there may be a possible delay and it may not go before the Board of Supervisors on July 31, 2012. Brandon Thompson will e-mail the plan, including the rollover amount to everyone prior to the meeting.

Tracey Quarne indicated there will be a meeting at the Office of Education regarding the Charter School on August 15, 2012, at 5:30 p.m. and would like a member from each agency to attend. He will put them at the top of the agenda so they may leave when AB 109 discussion is finished. (Thank you Tracey for the root beer floats and ice cream on a very hot day. ☺)

Motion for adjournment was made by Judge Twede and seconded by Robert Maloney at 2:35 p.m.

The next meeting of the CCP will be on July 19 2012, at 1:30 p.m. at the Willows Superior Court conference room.
