Call To Order and Attendance: CPO Thompson called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. and introductions were made by all present.

Approval of Minutes: Albert Smith moved to approve the Minutes from the July 25, 2013, meeting and Lucy Hernandez seconded the motion. Said minutes were approved.

Public Comment: There was no public comment from the floor on any item not on the agenda. Regarding public comment on agenda items, Lucy Hernandez stated she attended the National Community Action Conference. In speaking with Senator Jim Nielsen, Lucy indicated he complimented our program here in Glenn County and wants to speak with Brandon Thompson about it.

Information/Discussion/Action Items

- a. Updates – Information: Tracey Quarne indicated the Success One Charter School, which has a current location in Orland, will be presented to the School Board in October and then for approval at the November 20th meeting at 5:30 p.m. A letter of support will be submitted by the CCP Committee. He is also looking to secure a location for the charter school in Willows. He commended the CCP committee's modus operandi and the fact that they work so well together with such a healthy and positive attitude. In regards to the construction of the addition to the jail, Tracey indicated they will be donating a \$150,000.00 match for the classroom. Undersheriff Warren stated that completion of this addition is approximately four years out. The grant has not been approved yet and there is a lot of competition out there.
- b. Pre-trial program: Rick Beatty stated two tours were conducted regarding this program, both in Napa and Yolo Counties. Basically the process was the same with the exception of at what

point the judges become involved. It was decided that Glenn County would proceed on a case by case basis. In the majority of cases, we will have a pre-trial report done no later than at the time of arraignment. However, the program will have the capability of having the report completed before arraignment and in front of an on-call Judge. The Probation and Sheriff's Departments will work together, in that Probation will conduct the assessment and prepare the report for the Court, and the Sheriff's Department will supervise the individuals released on the program. The plan is to have the program up and running by November 1, 2013.

- c. Growth Allocation: A growth allocation chart prepared by the State Department of Finance was handed out and reviewed. CPO Thompson indicated these figures are not exact yet, but by the next meeting we should know what the allocations will be.
- d. Budget Report: The 2013/2014 Proposed Budget by Department's Requests and the allocation for each department receiving funds was also handed out and reviewed.
- e. 2013/2014 Proposed Budget – HRA Request: Lucy Hernandez explained her request (accompanied by handouts) for an increase in funding in the amount of \$26,056.00, reviewing their programs again and what is needed to run them and be successful. Most specifically the learning center, STAIRS and last year's statistics on that. Robert Maloney made the motion to approve the request and Chief Jason Dahl seconded the motion. Roll call was performed and said request was approved.

Probation Request: CPO Thompson requested approval for the purchase of a vehicle for the AB 109 Probation Officers to use. Chief Dahl made the motion to approve the request and Robert Maloney seconded the motion. Roll call was performed and said request was approved.

Notice of the next CCP meeting will be decided after a date can be agreed upon, as several of the members were not present to see what dates were available.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Tracey Quarne and seconded by Lucy Hernandez. The Meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.

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
