1. Call to Order & Attendance	<p>The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. by CPO Thompson with the following guests present:</p> <p>Glen Myers, Unity in Recovery, Timothy Irvin, Unity in Recovery, and Janelle Bartlett, Superior Court</p>
2. Review & Approval of Minutes & Agenda	<p>Motion on Minutes: Sheriff Jones Second: Judge Byrd Motion on Agenda: Judge Twede Second: Tracey Quarne Votes: Unanimous – both motions passed</p>
3. Public Comments	<p>No public comment was received.</p>
4. Board Member Reports	<p>Lucy Hernandez spoke on their pilot program (CREW) her department received. The informational flyer for this program is attached and expressed concern there was no guarantee as to funding beyond 6/30/12.</p> <p>John Viegas has had many contacts and conference calls at the State level regarding obtaining constitutional protection for AB 109.</p> <p>Sheriff Jones attended a gathering in Sacramento wherein Governor Brown showed his support of AB 109 and putting it on the ballot. However, Senator Doug LaMalfa was not in support of this. Of the four formats included in the Sacramento assembly, the Sheriff indicated the judge's panel was the most informative.</p>

<p>5. Information/Discussion</p>	<p>Regarding the distribution of funds, the Base fund allocation of \$331,271 has not yet been received nor has the D.A. or Public Defender funds (\$11,875). The Start-up funds (\$100,000) and the Training funds (\$23,375) have both been received. Nothing can be done without receipt of the Base fund allocation. Five percent of those funds will go towards an evaluation component to measure progress towards meeting the outcomes required of the program.</p>
<p>6. Pre-Trial Release Program update (Discussion)</p>	<p>This matter was discussed between the Sheriff and Chief Thompson who agreed that an assessment will be conducted on a person who has been arrested. If he/she is a low risk, they will have the authority to release the person; thus sparing the Court's time and keeping jail population down.</p>
<p>8. Status of CCP Plan (Discussion)</p>	<p>Chief Thompson indicated he would like to present the draft implementation plan to the CCP and indicated he will e-mail it to the group no later than October 11th. Chief Thompson indicated he wants to wrap the CCP Plan up and have it considered on the BOS agenda on November 1st, 2011.</p>
