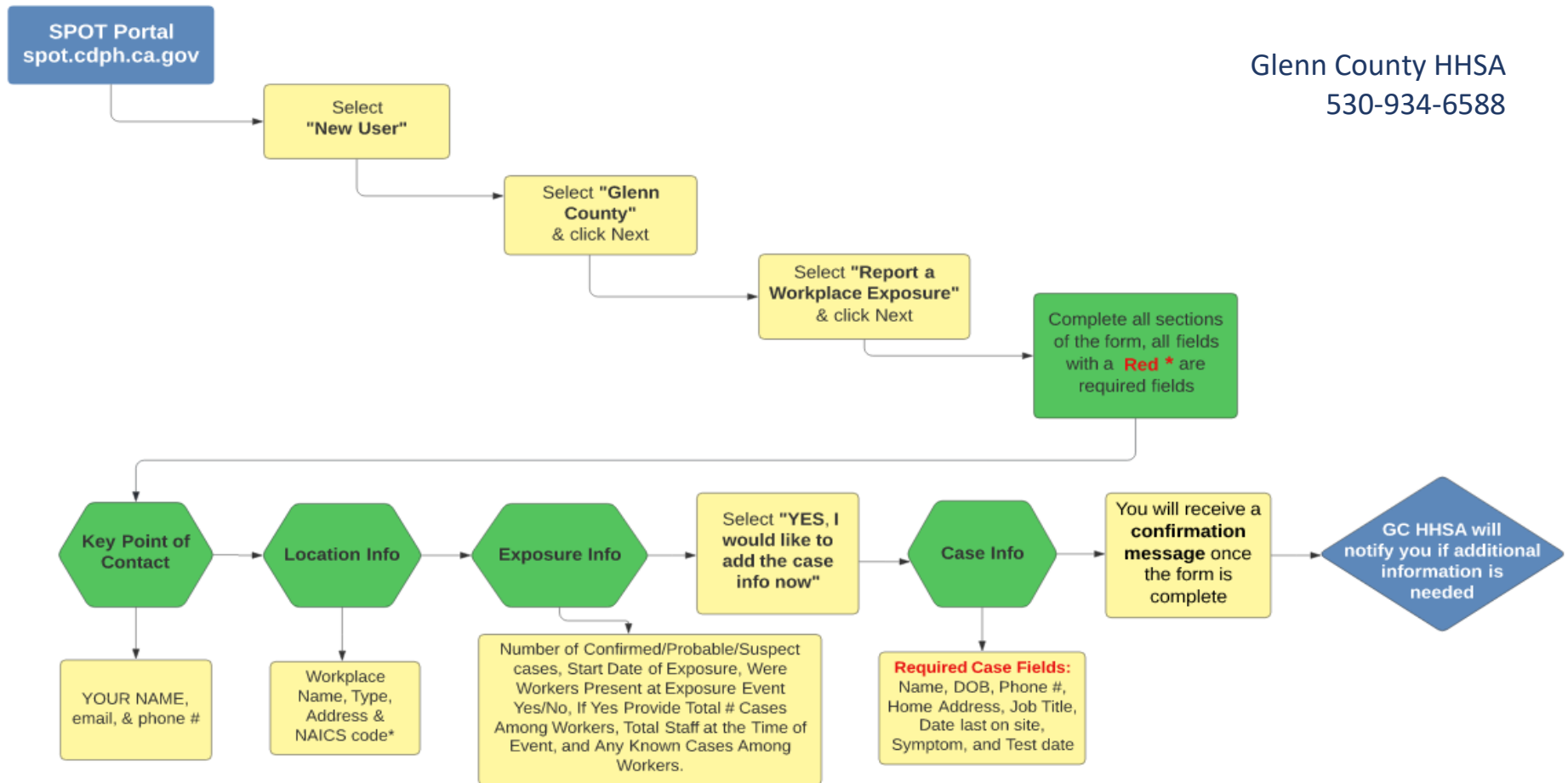

Glenn County Public Health partners with Glenn County businesses to mitigate COVID-19 outbreaks in the workplace. An outbreak in most worksites is defined as 3 or more cases of COVID-19 at a worksite within a 14-day period. Glenn County utilizes the Shared Portal for Outbreak Tracking (SPOT) to receive information about COVID-19 outbreaks in local business settings. SPOT makes it easy for business owners or managers to securely report COVID-19 outbreaks to Glenn County Public Health and receive assistance that can be utilized to slow the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace and community. This will allow for more efficient reporting and support. Please note that the previously required reporting to local health departments by businesses per AB 685 is no longer required as AB 685 is no longer in effect as of January 1, 2023. Businesses are encouraged to report outbreaks and reach out to Glenn County Public Health when questions arise.

Note: “Worksite” means the building, store, facility, agricultural field, or other location where a COVID-19 positive worker worked. This includes hallways, restrooms, lobbies, breakrooms, etc.”
