

Due to the Governors Executive Order #N-64-20, all voters will receive a Vote By Mail Ballot for the November 3, 2020 General Election. Voters may return their ballots by mail, in a secure drop box location, or in person to a Voter Assistance Center. Glenn County Elections Department will have two Voter Assistance Centers open to provide in-person voting opportunities, issue replacements ballots, and provide additional services. If you go to a voter assistance center, you will be asked to wear a mask and you will have to wait in line.
