# Job Search & Training Opportunity For Youth, Adult and Dislocated Workers

## To qualify for Adult and Dislocated Worker programs, you must be:

- 18 years or older
- A U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the US
- Registered for Selective Service (men 18-26 years)

## For the Dislocated Worker program:

- Unemployed due to a layoff or business closure
- Qualify for Unemployment Benefits (\$0 payout OK)
- Lost financial support from a partner
- Self-employment that didn't work out
- Long-term unemployed (more than 27 weeks)

## Youth Qualifications:

- 16- 24 years of age
  - In school Junior
  - In school Senior
- Low Income / Parenting
