**II. PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Dan Gamon offered to give a synopsis of the Managed Aquifer Recharge Symposium presented in part by GRA at an upcoming meeting if the committee felt it was appropriate.

- a. **WAC / ad hoc committee report**

The WAC had not met since the prior TAC meeting and therefore had nothing to report. The ad hoc committee met July 31. The group reviewed the Action List and discussed potential emergency measures under the county governance section. It is still under discussion. Allan Fulton is working on a newsletter specifically for Glenn County and a series focusing on domestic homeowners regionally. Several public outreach meetings are planned for this winter. The group plans to meet again in mid-September.

**b. Review of TAC responsibilities**

This item was postponed until the following meeting.

**c. Discussion and Possible Action Item – BMO Revision**

Continuing the discussion from the previous meeting, Lisa Hunter presented a number of options for revised BMO areas within the county. As per the TAC's recommendations from the previous meeting, the foothill basins were presented as one management area, the West Butte basin was presented as a separate basin, and the Corning basin was divided into East Corning and West Corning basins. The primary discussion centered on the division of the Colusa basin, with the TAC ultimately directing Ms. Hunter to bring back three more options, one of which should focus on medium to large management areas primarily following existing canal boundaries.

There was additional discussion concerning the benefits and difficulties of incorporating a vertical component into the BMO area revisions, and a recapitulation of the current stage alert definitions and actions triggered by the various stage alert levels. Cross sections provided by DWR were also reviewed. More review will take place at the next TAC meeting.

**d. Discussion and Possible Action Item – Ad Hoc Action List**

No discussion on this item took place.

**e. Other Topics of Interest**

John Brooks discussed that there may be additional resources available, such as additional cross-sections, through western universities and USGS.
