- 1. Question: What are the two alternatives?
- 1. Response:

- a. Shingles and built-up roof built-up roof only on flat roof
- b. PVC roofing on entire roof
- 2. Question: What is the duration of the project?
- 2. Response: 60 Calendar days from NTP.
- 3. Question: Projected start date?
- 3. Response: 10 days after board approval. Tentatively beginning of February.
- 4. Question: Has testing been performed for asbestos and lead?
- 4. Response: Testing has been performed for asbestos and lead paint both were negative.
- 5. Question: Site screen fence to be removed and NOT replaced?
- 5. Response: Yes, site screen is to be removed and NOT replaced.
- 6. Question: Most the flat deck is plywood. The one section in the rear is concrete?
- 6. That is correct.
- 7. Question: The slope of the roof is in the structure, not insulation?
- 7. Response: Correct.
- 8. Question: The air handling units will be removed by others?
- 8. Response: No, the air handling units will be removed by contractor or contractors sub.

- 9. Question: The equipment curbs will remain and not be replaced?
- 9. Response: Correct, unless damaged.
- 10. Question: Title 24 requirements will be enforced?
- 10. Response: Yes.
- **11.** Question: Penetrations (sleepers, pipes, air duct curbs, etc.) will be raised to a minimum of 6-8 inches above the finished roof line?
- 11. Response:
- **12.** Question: Material manufacturer, GAF will be submitted to provide a one source warranty on both the low and sleep slop roofs. PVC or TPO mil thickness (60), fleece back, adhered?
- **12.** Response: We will only be using PVC, not TPO. 60 mil per Durolast specs.
- **13.** Question: The existing gutters and related fascia board are not to be replaced. The gutters are to be cleaned and sealed as needed?
- **13.** Response: Gutters will remain as-is.
- 14. Question: The shingle valley-metal or woven?
- 14. Response: Metal/Galvanized
- 15. Question: Who is pulling the permit?
- 15. Response: Contractor.
- 16. Question: Who is providing the debris box for recycling materials?
- 16. Response: Contractor
- 17. Question: Who is replacing the wood work (dry rot, sleeper replacement, etc.)?
- 17. Response: Contractor
- 18. Question: Who is covering the electrical, painting, carpentry, mechanical, structural modifications?
- **18.** Response: County will be responsible for the painting and electrical (removing electrical only for the flagpole light) contractor will be responsible for all other electrical, mechanical, and structural.
- 19. Question: Will new roof vents be required? If so, please provide product specifications and quantity?
- **19.** Response: No, unless damaged.
- **20.** Question: If new insulation is required to achieve Title 24 status, new 2x4 nailers will need to be installed. Pressure treated or fire treated?
- **20.** Response: The roofing section will be removed and replaced with a ½" fiberboard and new 2-ply mod bit system. A new noising flashing will be installed along the perimeter rather than a drip edge.
- **21.** Question: The existing sleepers are NOT attached to the deck. New sleepers will need to be fastened to the deck. We will then box them in to make one solid curb.
- **21.** Response: Curbs will not be replaced, existing will remain, unless PVC is being used, please refer to Durolast specifications.
- **22.** Question: There are two layers of shingles, one layer of built-up roofing. This will create gap of approximately 1" from the deck to the existing gutters. How is this to be resolved? Plywood or lower the gutters?
- 22. Response: A counterflashing will need to be installed with manufacturer approved detail.
- 23. Question: What is the warranty requirement for the shingles?
- 23. Response: 40-year NDL
- 24. Question: Three-tab shingles or dimensional?
- 24. Response: As long as the manufacturer of the singles offers a 40-Year NDL, three tap is accepted.

25. Question: Shingle Color?

25. Response: A color sample board must be shown and accepted by County of Glenn.

- **26.** Question: Type of underlayment 30lb felt or self-adhering membrane?
- 26. Response: An Ice and Water underlayment must be used. A 15-30lb felt will not be accepted.
