Background

On October 26, 2023, the Department of Water Resources (DWR) issued a letter informing the Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) of its determination of the Colusa Subbasin GSP to be "incomplete". The letter outlined specific deficiencies and recommended corrective actions which include:

- a) Re-evaluation of the overdraft conditions in the Subbasin using the most recent data, and include projects and management actions to mitigate overdraft;
- b) Providing a more detailed explanation and justification of the sustainable management criteria for groundwater levels, particularly minimum thresholds and measurable objectives, and quantify the effects of those criteria on beneficial uses; and
- c) Providing a more detailed explanation and justification of sustainable management criteria, monitoring method, and projects and management actions related to land subsidence.

The consultant team (Davids Engineering) has been retained to complete the Colusa Subbasin GSP Revisions to address the identified deficiencies. Throughout the GSP revision process, the consultant team provided presentations and there was robust discussion and input on the identified deficiencies from the GSAs, committees, and members of the public. The CGA/GGA Joint TAC provided recommendations to the GSA Boards and Consultation Meetings were held with DWR, which also guided the GSP revision process. The CGA and GGA Board met jointly to reach consensus on various components and the direction of the GSP revisions in an open and transparent manner. The consultant team will review a summary of the Colusa Subbasin GSP revisions.

Pursuant to Water Code section 10728.4, a notice was sent on January 9, 2024 (GGA) and January 11, 2024 (CGA) to cities and counties within the area of the proposed plan. There were no requests for consultation meetings by the cities or counties.
