		<p>Behavioral Health Director Report - Joe reports 1.) Glenn Medical Center currently is without security. BH is working with GMC and local law enforcement to problem-solve the issue. GMC looking into hiring sitters. Meeting later this month. 2.) BHCIP – Program Funding Agreement has been completed. Team has been meeting with architect. Would like to illicit input/feedback from BHAB as a stakeholder group in future BHAB meetings. 3.) Proposition 1 – very close call, vote is nearly 50/50, however, likely to pass. Glenn County will apply for a waiver for the housing requirement. 4.) Mobile Crisis Unit (MCU) must be up and running by June 2024. MCU services will ensure that Medi-Cal beneficiaries have access to coordinated crisis care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. BH will begin working on contracts/MOUs. Also working on updated 5150 interagency MOU. 5.) BH will be asking CAO for permission to apply for round 3 of BH Bridge Housing. 6.) Mental Health Student Services Act (MHSSA) grant due to sunset next year; will be applying for additional funding. 7.) There is a new Board & Care facility in Chico called North Valley Transport.</p>
